



# Household Hazardous Waste Disposal for Flood Affected Properties ONLY

Household Hazardous Waste will be taken for **FREE** at the  
Riverside Temporary Transfer Station, 1225 Riverside Road.

**Dates: February 7 - 13, 2022**

**Hours: 8 am - 4 pm**

This service is for Abbotsford residents of **flood affected properties only**. Proof of address (e.g., photo ID or utility bill) is required to dispose of waste. Only waste that has been used for residential purposes will be accepted. Commercial or agricultural hazardous waste material is not accepted at this location.

Residents dropping off waste must remain in their vehicles at all times. Onsite staff will unload waste from truck beds or vehicle trunks or hatches. Items will not be accepted from the cabin of a vehicle or accepted through windows or doors. Boxes, totes and containers carrying or storing items for drop-off will not be returned, so please use original containers or place material in containers you don't need back.
